

# Asylum, Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF) 2021- 2027

## Questions and Answers

An information session was held by the Managing Authority at The Oaks Business Centre, Hamrun on Tuesday 30<sup>th</sup> April, during which several questions and answers were raised on the open calls for applications (AMIF Call 10 Strengthening legal migration and promoting integration and Call No. 11 Supporting victims of human trafficking) launched on 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2024 and 19<sup>th</sup> April 2024.

A summary of the list of Q&A delivered throughout the sessions can be found below:

Q. Can there be a partnership?

A. Yes, a partnership is possible.

Q. Are Indirect costs 7%?

A. Yes as indicated in the eligibility rules. 7 % shall cover administration costs, publicity, consumables, and other expenses related to the general implementation of the project.

Q. Is an awareness raising campaign a direct cost?

If an awareness raising campaign is one of the main actions proposed by the beneficiary, with clear outputs linked to it, it may be considered as a direct cost and hence it is to be indicated as a distinct work package. However, if the costs relate to the general promotion of the project, then it should be covered by the indirect costs.

Q. Is there pre-financing for these projects?

A. No, pre-financing at project level is not available.

Q. Does co-financing apply to a government entity?

A. Only NGOs or VOs have to present proof of co-financing at application stage. Government entities do not have to give co finance proof however budget allocations are foreseen to. Proof of co-financing need to be attested by bank statements, auditor or financial reports, or the entity accounts.

Q. If the lead applicant would be a government entity would partners have to provide co financing?

A. No, the government would generally co-finance the project.

Q. Is recruitment of human resources applicable to this call?

A. Yes, as long as it is inherent to the action being proposed. Administrative staff costs or recruitment costs are not eligible, as these fall under the indirect costs.

Q. Are victims of crime theological services eligible under this call?

A. It is eligible according to the organisation statute, whether for example the organisation is giving out assistance to ethnicity and it has to be linked with the action of the call.

Q. Do application have a minimum and a maximum threshold.

A. No not in this case.

Q. Does CPRD have a list of braille services and sign language interpreters.

A. Agenzija Sapport has a list of persons one can contact. It is advisable to contact well before organising an event where such services are needed, as there are only a few persons available.
