February Career Expo

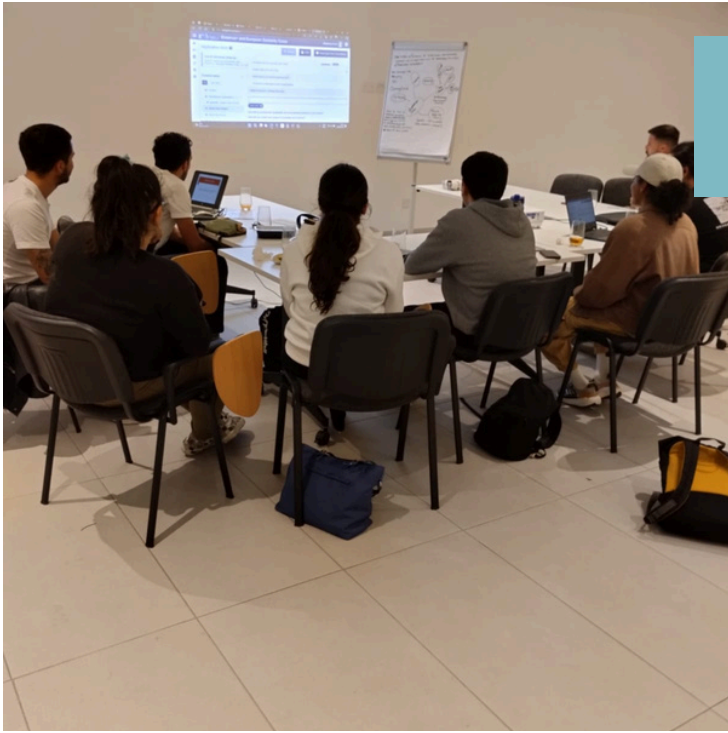

TRAINING OPPORTUNITIES!

There are a number of Erasmus+ Key Action 1 training courses, conferences and activities set to be held across various countries in the coming months. Applications are open and deadlines are soon approaching so hurry up!

- 10th May (deadline for application) - 'Key Enablers of a Transforming Digital Education Ecosystem' at Riga, Latvia - Participants will expand their insights of Digital Transformation within the context of the Erasmus+ programme.
- 15th May (deadline for KA1 application) - 'Inclusion for Newcomers' at Palermo, Sicily - An event with the aim of equipping participants with the necessary skills to develop projects that emphasise inclusion effectively.
- 24th May (deadline for KA2 application) - 'Design Thinking-Partnerships for Cooperation' at Dublin, Ireland. This is training programme will provide participants with the opportunity to develop their project ideas together using a Design Thinking approach.



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
