Capacity Building in the field of Youth

Deadline - 6 March at 17:00 (Brussels time)

Capacity-Building Projects in the field of youth promote international cooperation through multilateral partnerships between youth organisations in the EU and third countries associated to the programme, as well as third countries not associated with the programme. This action specifically targets countries in Region 1 (Western Balkans), Region 2 (Eastern Partnership), Region 3 (Southern Mediterranean), and Region 9 (Sub-Saharan Africa). These projects aim to support international cooperation in youth and non-formal learning, driving sustainable socio-economic development and well-being among youth organisations and young people. Virtual exchanges are aimed at higher education and youth organisations. They offer online activities that foster intercultural dialogue and develop soft skills. These projects ensure that all young people can access high-quality international and cross-cultural education without requiring physical mobility. Virtual exchanges are conducted in small groups, guided by trained facilitators, and are designed for seamless integration into youth non-formal education projects or higher education courses.
