**ANNOUNCEMENT OF A CALL FOR PROJECT PROPOSALS UNDER
The European Maritime Fisheries and Aquaculture Fund 2021-2027**

The Ministry responsible for European Funds would like to announce that it is launching a call for project proposals in the following area: **Specific Objective 1.1 – Strengthening economically, socially and environmentally sustainable fishing activities**

This call **shall be open to MFA and MFB licensed fishers** and shall specifically focus on **Diversification of fishing activities scheme targeting the development of complementary activities**, which may include inter alia investments on board, angling tourism, restaurants, environmental services related to fishing and educational activities. Investments may also be aimed that the retrofitting of Small Scale Coastal Fishing vessels for activities complementary to commercial fishing, thus increasing the potential for ancillary employment opportunities on land.

Applications should be submitted electronically on the Structural Funds Database available at **sfd.gov.mt/application** by not later than **10th October 2025, 31st December 2025, 31st March 2026, 30th June 2026, 30th September 2026 and 31st December 2026 at noon**.
