€14 Million in European Funding Committed in Round 1 and Round 2 of 2025

The European Union Programmes Agency, Malta's National Agency responsible for the implementation of EU educational and training initiatives, has officially published the results of Round 1 and Round 2 for 2025. A total of over **€14 million** has been committed to support various projects under the Erasmus+ and European Solidarity Corps programmes.

The committed funding under Erasmus+ and the European Solidarity Corps covers a diverse range of sectors, supporting both formal and non-formal education.

The **Hon. Dr Stefan Zrinzo Azzopardi**, Minister for European Funds and the Implementation of the Electoral Programme welcomed the results, stating:

"The Government remains committed to strengthening investment in both education and informal training. These projects foster mobility and inclusion, giving students and youth the opportunity to expand their horizons, skills, and experiences across Europe."

Prospective applicants are encouraged to begin preparing their submissions for the next round, which will close at **noon on 1st October 2025**.

€14 -il Miljun f'Finanzjament Ewropew Allokati fl-Ewwel Sejha tal-2025

L-Aġenzija tal-Unjoni Ewropea għall-Programm Erasmus+, li hija l-Aġenzija Nazzjonali responsabbli mill-implimentazzjoni tal-programmi edukattivi u ta' taħriġ tal-UE f'Malta, ippubblikat ir-riżultati uffiċjali tal-Ewwel ut-Tieni Sejha għall-2025. Total ta' aktar minn **€14 il-miljun** ġie allokati biex jappoġġja proġetti f'diversi setturi taħt il-programmi Erasmus+ u Korp Ewropew ta' Solidarjetà.

Il-finanzjament approvat jindirizza setturi differenti kemm fl-edukazzjoni formali kif ukoll f'dik informali.
