## European Commission Endorses Malta's Social Climate Plan

Malta has taken an important step towards a fair and inclusive green transition following the European Commission's endorsement of the country's Social Climate Plan. The plan will mobilise €60.6 million up to 2032 to support vulnerable households, micro-enterprises and transport users as Malta continues its journey towards climate neutrality.

The Social Climate Plan forms part of the European Union's Social Climate Fund, which aims to ensure that no one is left behind as Europe advances its climate objectives. The funding will help address the social impacts associated with the green transition through targeted measures and investments benefitting those most affected.

Malta's plan is designed to support vulnerable groups and small businesses while contributing to the country's environmental and climate ambitions. The endorsement makes Malta one of the Member States whose Social Climate Plan has been approved under the Social Climate Fund framework.

As Malta advances towards a greener and more resilient future, the Social Climate Plan represents another important milestone in ensuring that the benefits of the green transition are shared by all.
