### Introduction

- Regulation 4 of Legal Notice 497 of 2010
  - SEA must be carried out for certain plans & programmes or their modifications that are likely to have a significant effect on the environment
- SEA carried out on OPI in 2006
- OPI subsequently modified & approved in 2009
- Proposed changes to OPI now require re-assessment





#### Main Changes:

- PA4: investment in infrastructure to generate energy from natural sources
- PA4: actions that seek to make better use of resource available
- PA6: addition of the project to construct the Oncology Centre





## Methodology

- Two-tiered approach:
  - 1. Is the change to OPI major or minor and was the change assessed in SEA done in 2006?
  - If change is major, or not assessed in SEA of 2006, then further assessment is required





## **Findings**

#### Infrastructure for to generate energy from natural sources:

- Could have a significant environmental effect depending on location
- Planning process would assess impacts of individual projects
- Assessed in SEA for Waste Strategy

#### **Further treatment and reuse of TSE:**

- Unlikely to have significant environmental effects
- Assessed in the SEA on the draft Water Policy

#### **Construction of the Oncology Centre:**

- Construction Temporary impacts e.g. noise & dust
- Operation Traffic generation
- No EIA required by MEPA





#### **Conclusions**


None of the proposed changes to the OP warrant a new SEA because:

- 1. Some proposals have been assessed by sectoral SEAs
- 2.Individual projects would be assessed by the planning process
- 3.Impacts of some of the proposals would not be major
