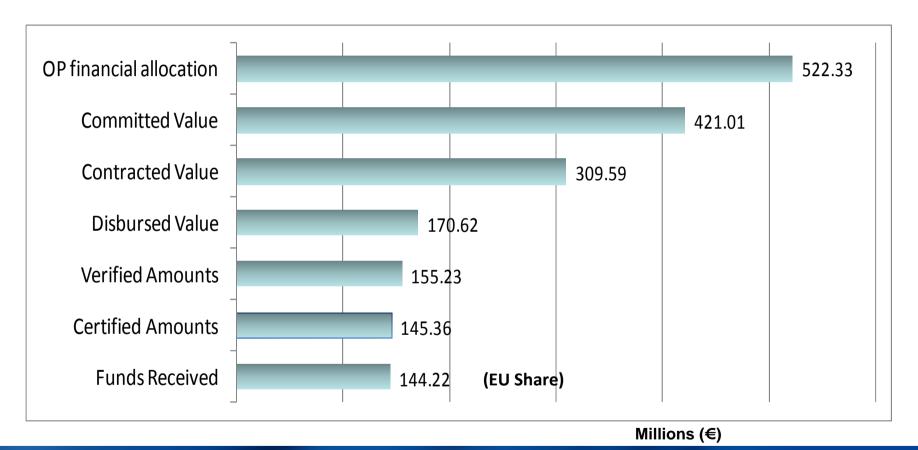

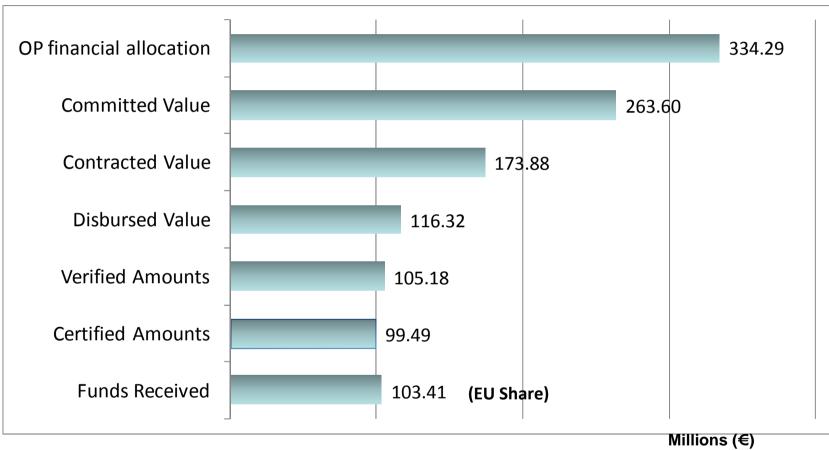

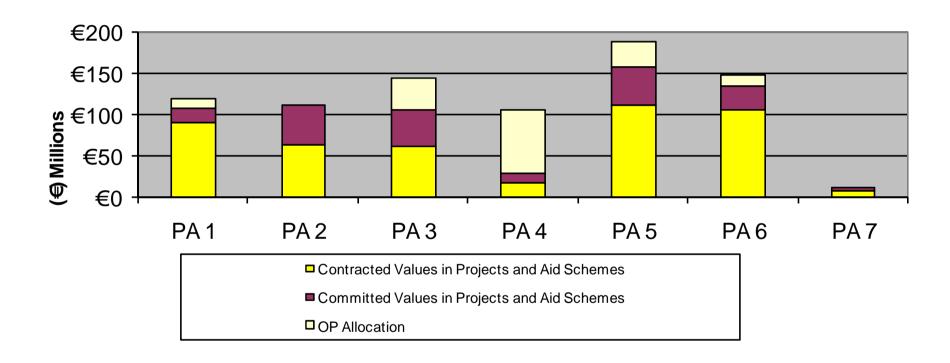

Update on Results (2)



- Over 11,896kWp/annum of RES systems installed
 - 17,844 MWH/annum of total annual electricity to be generated from small scale PVs
 - 15,671 Tonnes of CO2 emissions saved
- 10% (30,000m²) of rehabilitated Landfill
- Over 18,000 students benefitting from upgrade and modernized facilities/services (per annum)

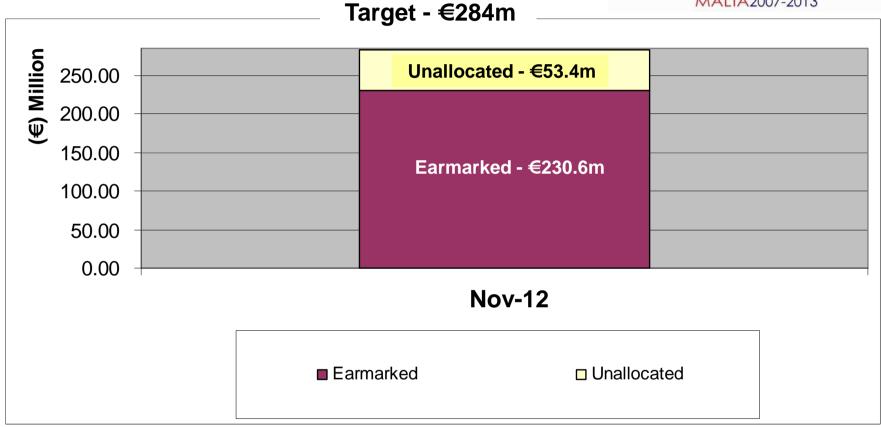

- 3. Analyse and assess the output and result indicators and any monitoring data.
- 4. Recommend how the actions which are being undertaken could be strengthened in future Programmes and identify examples of good practice.
- 5. Analyse the contribution of OPI initiatives to the crosscutting horizontal themes of Equal Opportunities and Environmental Sustainability.

Concluding Remarks



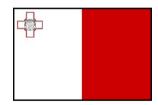
- The MA will continue to work on achieving 100% commitment of the OP;
