- Development of Fisheries Infrastructure to consolidate and improve the current infrastructure servicing the fisheries industry
- Improving Competitiveness of the Fisheries, Aquaculture and Processing Sectors
- Achieve a sustainable fishing effort
- Safeguard current jobs





## Implementing 4 Priority Axes

- Axis 1: Adaptation of the Community fishing Fleet
  - Allocated Budget of 2,900,000€(75% EU Funds & 25% Malta Funds)
- Axis 2: Aquaculture, processing and marketing of fishery and aquaculture products
  - Allocated Budget 2,347,000€(75% EU Funds & 25% Malta Funds)





- Axis 3: Measures of common interest
  - Allocated Budget 5,460,105€(75% EU Funds & 25% Malta Funds)
- Axis 5: Technical Assistance
  - Allocated Budget 456,000€(75% EU Funds & 25% Malta Funds)





# Priority Axis 1 — Adaptation of the Community Fishing Fleet

- Permanent & Temporary Cessation Allocated Budget of 1,500,000€
- Modernisation of the fishing fleet
   Allocated Budget of 890,000€
   Co-Financing Rate:
   40% EFF Funds
   (75% EU Co-financing Rate 25% Malta Govt)
   60% Private Contribution
- Socio Economic increase training in fishers Allocated Budget of 500,000€
- Publicity Allocated Budget 10,000 €
