# European Fisheries Fund 2007 – 2013 State of Play Development from the last Monitoring Committee

**Priority Axis 1:** 

Measures for the adaptation of the Maltese Fishing Fleet





### Permanent Cessation

#### First Call

- The first permanent cessation call was concluded.
- A total of €1.1 million has been spent for the scheme
- 9 vessels have been scrapped

#### Second Call

- A second call for the permanent cessation scheme has been published, and evaluated.
- The results were published on the press and were followed by 10 calendar days.
- 4 Appeals have been submitted and an appeals board including public hearing have been organised.
- Presently the appeals evaluation board is analysing and finalising the results.
- As the appeals results are published on the press, a letter of acceptance will be forwarded to the final beneficiaries and the implementation of the scheme could be effected as soon as possible.
- By the end of the year, 5 or 6 fishing vessels targeting BFT and Swordfish will be demolished and removed from the fishing vessel register.





### Investments on Board Fishing Vessels & Selectivity

- 50 applicants applied for the scheme. Out of these, 45 were eligible for funding and 5 were not eligible for funding
- Out of the 45 eligible applications, 33 beneficiaries signed the agreement
- Total Committed Funds: Approximately €210,00
- Currently, final beneficiaries are commissioning, procuring, and installing the approved items
- Financing for the change in engines are currently ceased
- Several fishing vessels completed their projects
- On the spot checks have been done on several vessels
- Items that were procured are;
   Radars, Autopilots, Safety Equipment, Change of Engines,
   Modernising the vessel structure etc..

### Productive investments in aquaculture

- Guidelines for applicants have been drafted and forwarded to the Managing authority for feedback and approval
- 1 million euro is budgeted for this scheme





## Investments in Processing and Marketing of Fisheries and Aquaculture Products

- Presently, final beneficiaries are commissioning, procuring, and installing the approved items
- Projects are under way.
- Payments effected to date: approximately €175,000–40% grant
- Payments effect by the Final Beneficiaries: approximately €440,000
- During the implementation of the project on the spot checks are being carried out in order to verify the invoices and fiscal receipts that are being submitted.

#### **Measures of Common Interest**

Fishing Ports, Landing Sites and Shelters

- Relocation of the Fish Market
- The MEPA permit has been issued
- A Tender for the construction of the fish market has been drafted, approved by the Department of Contracts and published on the 18<sup>th</sup> November and will be closed on the 10<sup>th</sup> January 2012
- Works should follow the award of the contract.
