2. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The initial stage of the new programming period was dedicated to drafting and finalising the National Strategic Plan, the ex-ante Evaluation and the Strategic Environmental Assessment. During 2008, a number of bilateral meetings were held with the Commission regarding Malta's Operational Programme for Fisheries 2007-2013, which was approved in December 2008. The Operational Programme has been prepared in accordance with Council Regulation (EC) No. 1198/2006 and plans to implement three axes of the EFF and the technical assistance measure. The priority axes adopted for the Operational Programme are as follows:

- Axis 1 Adaptation of the Community fishing fleet; budget € 2,900,000
- Axis 2 Aquaculture, processing and marketing of fishery and aquaculture products;
 budget € 2,347,000
- Axis 3 Measures of common interest; budget € 5,460,105
- Axis 4 N/A
- Axis 5 Technical assistance; budget € 456,000

In accordance with the EU's strategic guidelines, the Operational Programme will contribute to important objectives such as achieving a sustainable fishing effort, diversification of the fisheries product, increase in competitiveness of the sector, enhancement of fishing skills, the safeguarding of jobs, improved working conditions and the application of increased

innovation. No measures have been launched due to the fact that the EFF Operational Programme was approved in December 2008.

3.4 Qualitative analysis

No information can be provided at this stage as projects are not being implemented as yet.

3.5 Monitoring arrangements

The provisions for the implementation of the Operational Programme are in line with Article 57 and 58 of Council Regulation 1198/2006, General principles of the management and control systems, establishing both the general principles of the management and control systems as well as the designation of the relevant authorities. Hence a Managing Authority to manage the OP, a Certifying Authority to certify statements of expenditure and applications for payments before they are sent to the European Commission, and an Audit Authority, which must be independent of the Managing Authority and the Certifying Authority, will be responsible for verifying the effective functioning of the management and control system.

The EU Affairs Directorate within the Ministry for Resources and Rural Affairs was entrusted with the management and overall coordination of the OP. The EU Paying Authority within the Ministry of Finance, the Economy and Investment has been appointed to carry out the function of the Certifying Authority, whilst the Internal Audit and Investigations Directorate has been appointed as the Audit Authority for the OP.

The Operational Programme has been subject to an ex ante-evaluation and will be subject to an interim and an ex port evaluation in accordance with the provisions of Articles 48, 49 and 50 of Council Regulation 1198/2006. The aim of the evaluations is to improve the quality and effectiveness of the assistance from the EFF and the implementation of the OP. The evaluation will appraise the impact with respect to the guiding principles set out in Article 19, the relevant parts of the National Strategic Plans and specific problems affecting Malta, while taking account of the needs of sustainable development in the fisheries sector and the environmental impact.

3.6 Significant problems encountered and measures taken to overcome them

Some problems were encountered due to the limited administrative capacity within the Veterinary Regulations Fisheries Conservation and Control Division which has caused delays in the drafting and approval of the programme.

3.7 Recommendations from the Commission following annual examination of the Operational Programme

The Commission has not issued any recommendations.

3.8 Assistance repaid or re-used

No assistance was repaid or re-used. The Operational Programme is still in its initial stages.

3.9 Substantial modification within the meaning of Article 56 of Regulation (EC) No 1198/2006

There was no substantial modification within the meaning of Article 56 of Regulation (EC) No. 1198/2006.

3.10 Changes in the context and general conditions to the implementation of the Operational Programme

There were no changes in the context and general conditions to the implementation of the Operational Programme.

4. THE USE MADE OF TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

It is envisaged that the Managing Authority and the Veterinary Regulations Fisheries Conservation and Control Division will seek funds under the Technical Assistance budget to cover the salaries of the new recruits which are needed to implement the new programme.

5. INFORMATION AND PUBLICITY

No information and publicity have been undertaken so far as the programme is still in its initial stages.

6. INFORMATION ABOUT COMPLIANCE WITH COMMUNITY LAW

No significant problems have been encountered with respect to compliance with Community law.

7. COMPLEMENTARITY WITH OTHER INSTRUMENTS

EU Regulations governing the European Fisheries Fund (EFF), the European Agricultural Fund for Regional Development (EAFRD) and the Structural Funds specify that the respective strategies and Operational Programmes must set out how the different funding streams will complement each other. In Malta, the Managing Authority for Cohesion Policy is the Planning and Priorities Coordination Division (PPCD) within the Office of the Prime Minister (OPM), the Managing Authority for the EAFRD is the Rural Development Department, whilst for the EFF, the Managing Authority is the EU Affairs Directorate within the Ministry for Resources and Rural Affairs (MRRA).

The NSRF, the NSP and the RDP have all been developed with particular attention being given to areas where programme activity could indeed overlap.

Complementarity of actions will be regularly reviewed through quarterly evaluations and an annual meeting of the three Managing Authorities. The strategic and operational fit between the programmes will also be part of any mid-term evaluation. Furthermore, the EFF Managing Authority is represented on the Inter Ministerial Co-ordination Committees that were set up by the Managing Authority for Cohesion Policy in order to enhance co-ordination between the different funding mechanisms and also to ensure synergy and complementarity between the different initiatives in order to minimise risks with regard to overlaps and duplication of effort.
