- Cohort Study on Training co-financed by the ESF in Malta and Gozo (Update – Wave 3)
- ✓ The target population for Wave 3 consisted of all persons who
 participated in courses or training projects co-financed by the ESF
 from 1st February 2012 to 31st July 2013
- ✓ A total of 8,298 persons were eligible to participate in the survey

Evaluation Activities

The demographic profile of the 8,298 participants is as follows:

Table 1. Distribution of trainees by sex and age group


Labour Status: Before and After Training

- 2,677 respondents experienced a positive change in their labour status
- Those who experienced a positive change were mainly:
 - Disadvantaged persons
 - ✓ Persons aged 65 years
 - ✓ Respondents who were unemployed prior to the ESF training.
 - √ Female respondents





Change in labour status by past employment







Evaluation Activities (6) Perceived Contribution of ESF Training: Short-term

- 91% of those who claimed that their labour status changed for the better, attributed this change to ESF training
- 94% of persons aged between 15 and 24 years of age and 55 and 64 years of age perceived ESF training as the factor improving their labour status
- 87% of those who were previously unemployed and considered ESF as having improved their labour status were economically active at the time of the survey
- Nearly 48% perceive ESF training as having contributed towards the enhancement or maintaining of employability. This was particularly true for migrants and female respondents





Perceived Contribution of ESF Training: Long term

- 87.2% of participants perceived that the training received would help them in the future
- This was mainly true for females, non-vulnerable persons, inactive in education and training and employment when the survey was being conducted

- Conclusion of June 2012 EC Audit
- DG OLAF July 2012 Audit still not concluded
- Audit carried out by the European Court of Auditors in December 2012 and February 2013.
