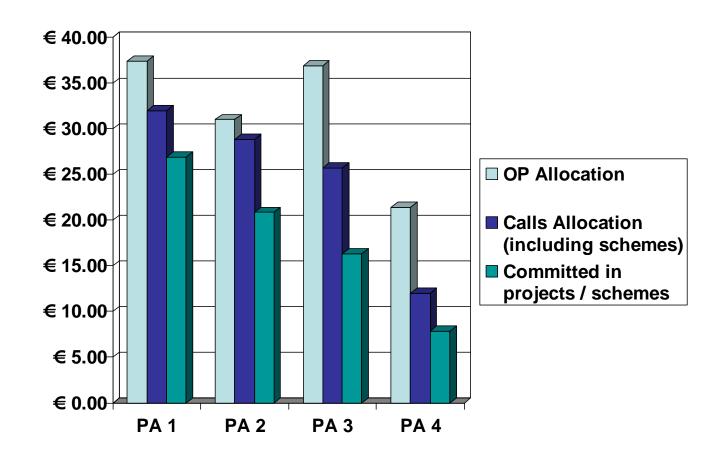

#### **Projects submitted under Call 5**

#### **Priority Axis 2** (All Focus Areas)

- Total Value of Call €10,000,000
- 14 projects were submitted
- 6 projects were selected for co-funding. The amount committed for these 6 projects totals €1,617,391.43
  - > 3 projects related to the tourism sector
  - > 1 project related to IT
  - 1 project related to life-long learning of civil society organisations in a locality
  - 1 project related to industrial needs and VET









# **Projects submitted under Call 5**

#### **Priority Axis 4** (All Focus Areas)

- Total Value of Call €12,000,000
- 16 projects were submitted
- 7 projects were selected for co-funding. The amount committed for these 7 projects totals €7,875,513
  - 4 projects are targeting the public administration
  - 2 projects are targeting socio-economic partners
  - ➤ 1 project withdrawn by Beneficiary





# **Update on Projects: Priority Axis 4**

- Most tenders are currently being prepared (drafting and vetting stages).
- 5 projects launched calls/tenders
- 3 contracts signed under 2 projects
- 2 projects started implementation (ESF4.100, ESF4.86)

## **Lisbon Agenda – Earmarking**

- €92,500,800 are earmarked for Lisbon Agenda related projects.
- 45 Projects/schemes (totalling €56,721,196) under implementation are contributing to the earmarked categories.
- This is equivalent to 61.3% of the earmarked amount.





# Implementation of Approved Projects

#### **Examples of Projects:**

- **ESF1.34** Addressing Skills Mismatches in the Aviation Maintenance Industry
  - 183 students are being trained (target for 1<sup>st</sup> year was 142)
  - 3 lecturers are job-shadowing
- ESF 2.4 Employability Programme
  - Over 8,400 participants
  - 67 courses on offer









# Implementation of Approved Projects

- ESF3.54 Opportunities Close to Home
  - A total of 323 applications received
  - 108 participants commenced the beginners' courses in March
  - Other courses (the City and Guilds course and ECDL) are forecasted to start in June and August.
- **ESF 3.61** *E4L:* Embark for Life Labour market integration of socially excluded youth
  - 149 participants are benefitting
  - 13 of them have already been integrated into the labour market
  - 19 are being assisted to maintain their employment





#### Training Aid Framework ESF2.65

- 1470 applications have been received to-date. Out of these applications, 151 were withdrawn (10%)
- The number of Grant Agreements signed to-date totals 692:
  - 194 from small enterprises (28%)
  - 196 from medium undertakings (28%)
  - 302 from large undertakings (44%)







# Aid Schemes (2)

#### Employment Aid Programme ESF3.64

- 1357 Applications have been received to-date
- To date, 654 Grant Agreements have been signed:
  - > 379 (58%) males
  - > 275 (42%) females
  - > 216 (33%) Gozitans







# **Monitoring and Reporting**

- Day-to-day
- Project Progress Reporting requested 3 times per year (29 reports received in mid-May)
- Ministerial Projects Steering Committees (MPSC) 4 meetings have been scheduled by 4 Ministries (MEEF, MITC, MGOZ, OPM) in the first half of 2010
- Intermediate Bodies Steering Committees (IBSC)
- Inter-ministerial Co-ordinating Committee (IMCC) bi-annual
- PPS high level meetings held monthly 25 Projects were reviewed in 2010
- Cabinet updates (provided regularly)









#### **Structural Funds Database**

- New domain for the browser based version: <a href="https://www.sfd.gov.mt/login.aspx">https://www.sfd.gov.mt/login.aspx</a>
- New SFD Treasury application released to cater for the Treasury's specific requirements.
- New or updated modules released: EU Payment Request, Focus Areas, Annex XXIII, Indicators, Project Invoices Report, User rights management, and Group access rights.
- Debtors' ledger in final testing stage.
- Four training sessions have been organised in 2010 whilst another two sessions are planned for this month.
- System manuals were updated on users' feedback, including two major releases: Annex I: IBs, Annex II: NGOs.
- Follow-Up of Data Protection Audit (MA Circular 3/2010).
- Bi-monthly meetings of development team.
- Data protection audit.







## **Financial Control**

- Management Verifications
  - ➤ 44 Documentary on-the-spot checks
  - ➤ 49 Physical on-the-spot checks
- Systems Audit initiated on 02.07.09 and concluded 30.04.10. Assurances confirmed
- Audits on operations have started









# **Information and Publicity**

- Preparations are currently underway to launch tender for the Annual Event 2010 envisaged to be held in early September in both Malta and Gozo.
- The event will be an outdoor activity with entertainment and animation for the general public, but of particular interest to families.
- Dissemination of Information on OPII on various media communications.
- Review of Communication Plan.
- Flying the EU flag between the 7<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> May 2010.





#### **Evaluation Activities**

- Tender of the Mid-term Evaluation covering OPII was awarded to KPMG.
- Kick off meeting held on the 26th April 2010.
- Inception report submitted on 7th May 2010.
- First round of stakeholders' meetings were held on the 12th May 2010. Four sessions were held with a total participants of 29 (OPII beneficiaries) and 17 representatives of the Horizontal stakeholders.

NEXT: approval by MA of the revised inception report.



#### **Evaluation Activities**

#### **Cohort Study**

- Following discussions with experts (statisticians and IT stakeholders) it is no longer deemed possible to undertake a full tracking system
- A cohort study will be undertaken





# **Training and Capacity Building**

- Training on the Structural Funds Database held in April 2010 (Annex XXIII and Indicators)
- Training on the Management Tools for Monitoring held between January and February 2010 (26 participants)
- Introduction to Payment Procedures: Guidelines to VAT held in March 2010 (67 Beneficiaries)
- Training to Line Ministries on Project Progress Report (template) held in March 2010.









#### **Concluding Remarks on first half of 2010**

- Very challenging, particularly in view of accelerated implementation (2007-2013) coinciding with the closure of the 2004-2006 programme
- Half way through the programming period → 58.53% of the OP committed
- Acceleration of contracting and disbursements
- Start of Mid-term Evaluation
- Fine-tuning of procedures the Programme is now fully on course with most of the administrative structures complete





#### Conclusions on latter half of 2010

- Efforts will be sustained in terms of accelerated commitments, contracting and disbursements, particularly with regard to aid schemes.
- Conclusions of pending Grant Agreements
- Conclusion of flat-rate study
- Launch of tender for Cohort Study
