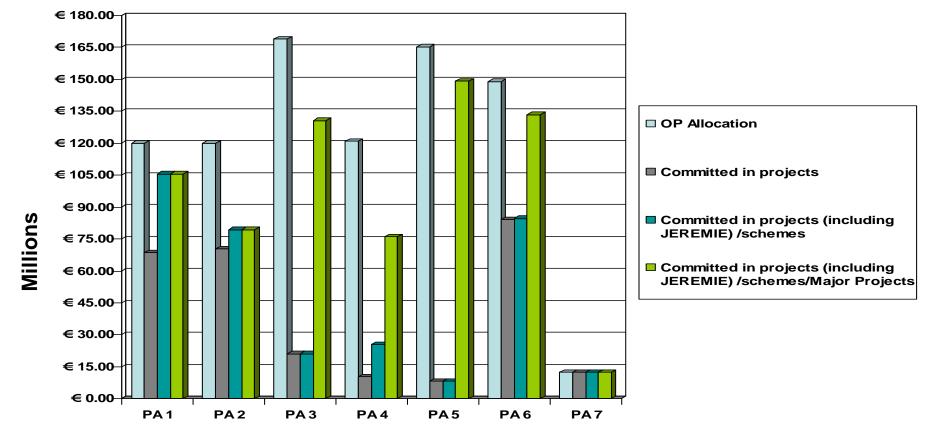

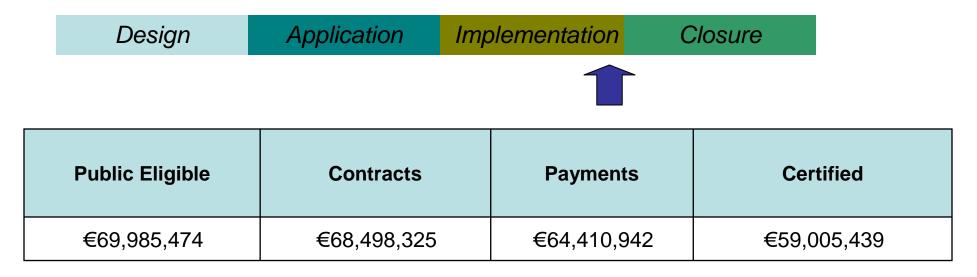

### Lisbon Agenda - Earmarking



- Slight decrease in earmarked categories for Lisbon Agenda related projects mainly due to :
  - Savings registered in projects during the contracting process;
  - Withdrawal of two projects within the Energy Focus Area.
- 35 Projects/Schemes (amounting to €181,174,392) under implementation are contributing to the earmarked categories



### JEREMIE



- 3 Applications from Financial Intermediaries received in November 2010
- In 2011 a successful bidder was selected – Bank of Valletta
- Agreement between JEREMIE Holding Fund (EIF) and Financial Intermediary (BOV) signed on 6<sup>th</sup> April 2011
- Extensive advertising by BOV on local media and bank website.

Action Plan 2011 approved on 18th March 2011 and will assist the following projects:-

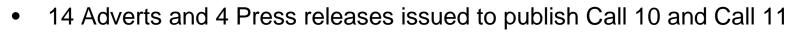

### **Outcomes of the MTE**



#### Relevance:

- the OP is still relevant in today's socio-economic context
- there is a balance between policies and the activities being co-financed

### Efficiency:

• evidence of 'ramping up' supporting the view that current process leading up to approval of projects does not present major indication of bottlenecks

### Effectiveness:

• for most part, planned achievement percentages of output and result indicators show healthy prospects of likely achievement



### **Review of Communication Plan**



- Final Report on the Communication Plan (by the MTE) was submitted to the MA on 13 April 2011
- The MA has taken the findings of the MTE into consideration and is currently concluding the review as proposed at the May 2010 MC
- The revision will provide for:
  - better monitoring structure of information and publicity;
  - as well as a strategy which is more focused on the promotion of tangible results.



## Training & Capacity Building



### 12 January 2011

 5 officers from the Financial Control Unit within the MA participated in in-house training on the Assurance Model and Modification to Article 55 'Revenue Generating Projects'

### 8 - 11 March 2011

 20 officers participated in training on Cost Benefit Analysis of Structural and Cohesion Funds Projects

### 29 March 2011

- 13 officers from the MA participated in a seminar organised by the European Court of Auditors on 'Sound Financial Management of EU Funds'
- Other participants included the CA, AA, IBs and Beneficiaries



## Assistance in Cost Benefit Analysis
