




Overview of the Operational Programme I






Overview of the ERDF







N+3 Targets for ERDF






N+3 Targets for Cohesion Fund



Progess towards N+3 **CF (N+3 EU)**








- Stakeholders should ensure the proper implementation of projects under their portfolio

- An increase in the number of verifications is expected and needed in 2013


