### **Communication & Publicity Activities Implemented in 2017**

- Calls were promoted through adverts published on the Government Gazzette and on all local Sunday printed newspapers;
- A pre-launch press conference and informal meetings were also held in January 2017 to prepare fishermen accordingly;
- Potential applicants were also notified of the issuance of the calls and of the information sessions being held via sms notification;
- Information sessions and meetings were held for all open and restricted calls;
  - Two information sessions were held for Calls issued under **UP1** targeting Fishermen Calls (one in Gozo and one in Malta)
  - An information session was also held for the open call issued under UP2 with prospective aquaculture applicants
- Guidance was also provided by MA officials on a daily basis through phone and email exchanges and meetings held with prospective applicants to address queries.





### **Communication & Publicity Activities Implemented in 2018**

- Calls were also promoted through adverts published on the Government Gazzette and on all local Sunday printed newspapers;
- Similarly to 2017, potential applicants were also notified of the issuance of the calls via sms notification;
- Information sessions and meetings were held for interested applicants;
- Further assistance to applicants was provided by other stakeholders, namely the DFA and the Ministry of Gozo.
   With the aim of ensuring impartially, officials external to the MA were appointed to assist fishermen in filling application forms and/or assisting fishermen in their queries;
- Prior to the provision of this assistance, training was also provided by the MA to the appointed officials with the aim of providing the necessary information and guidance.



### **Update on OP Commitments**

- As at end 2017, **EUR 17,232,860** (total public eligible) were committed out of the total contribution of EUR 28,903,707. Due to the withdrawal of the Delimara project under Article 43 in 2018, as at time of reporting the total public eligible of committed funds is **EUR 15,350,998**.
- The MA foresees that by Q2 2018, a further **EUR 3,968,000** may be allocated subject to grant award of projects being/to be evaluated by the PSC under UP1, UP2 and UP3. This is expected to increase by July 2018 whereby a further **EUR 2,786,483** may be allocated under UP1 Article 43 in respect of applications submitted for calls issued in Q1 2018.
- This will amount to about **76.48% of allocated EMFF Funds**.
- The remaining funds will be committed in 2018 and 2019 following issuance of further calls in 2018 and onwards.





#### **EMFF MT State-of-Play of Allocated Funds**


