#### Call 1 - [UP3] Data Collection

- **Eligible Applicants:** Ministry for Sustainable Development, the Environment and Climate Change [MSDEC]
- Call Closing Date: 29<sup>th</sup> April 2016
- Amount Allocated for the Call: € 2,500,000 [Public Eligible]
- Awarded Public Eligible Amount: € 1,822,425
- **EMFF Co-Financing Rate:** 80%
- Call type: Restricted
- Project Duration: 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2017





#### Call 1 - [UP3] Data Collection [cont.]

- A restricted call was issued on the 11<sup>th</sup> March 2016 on the basis of Article 77 of Regulation [EU] No. 508/2014, to which one application was received from MSDEC.
- In line with the EMFF OP, for the period 2014-2016 Malta will implement the National Programme 2014 2016 as laid down in the Commission Decision C[2013] 5568 of 30th August 2013.
- Operation Summary: This operation includes the collection, use and management of fisheries data in line with Council Regulation EC No. 199/2008 and Commission Decision [2010/93/EU] and as outlined in the National Programme for the collection of primary biological, technical, environmental and socio-economic data in the fisheries sector of the Republic of Malta, 2011 2013 National Programme.





#### Call 2 - [UP6] Fostering the Implementation of the IMP

- **Eligible Applicants:** MSDEC
- **Application Closing Date:** Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> August 2016
- Amount Allocated for the Call: € 1,600,000 [Public Eligible]
- Awarded Public Eligible Amount: € 1,600,000
- **EMFF Co-Financing Rate:** 75%
- **Call type:** Restricted
- **Project Duration:** 1st Quarter 2019





### Call 2 - [UP6] Fostering the Implementation of the IMP [cont.]

- A restricted call was issued on the 9<sup>th</sup> June 2016 on the basis of Article 80.1[c] of Regulation [EU] No. 508/2014, inviting the MSDEC [as a co-ordinating body] to submit an application.
- The **Environment and Resources Authority** [ERA] in partnership with Malta Marittima Agency, Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture and Transport Malta applied for this call.
- Operation Summary: The project will initiate the implementation of sustained environmental monitoring in marine waters with the aim to assess the state of Malta's marine waters on a continuous basis and address current knowledge gaps. This monitoring would provide a sound knowledge base for effective management of anthropogenic activities and work towards achievement of Good Environmental Status [GES] in marine waters.





## Call 3 - [UP1] Fishing Ports, Landing Sites, Auction Halls & Shelters

- Eligible Applicants: MSDEC; Ministry for Transport and Infrastructure (MTI)
- **Application Closing Date:** Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2016
- **Amount Allocated:** € 9,230,572 [Public Eligible]
- Eligible Amount: to be determined
- **EMFF Co-Financing Rate:** 75%
- Call type: Restricted
- Project Duration: to be determined





## Call 3 - [UP1] Fishing Ports, Landing Sites, Auction Halls & Shelters [cont.]

- A **restricted call** was issued on the **20<sup>th</sup> October 2016** on the basis of **Article 43.1+3 + 44.1[f] of Regulation [EU] No. 508/2014**, inviting the MSDEC and MTI to submit applications.
- <u>Potential Operations</u>: Improving the infrastructure in fishing ports and existing landing sites
- As at time of reporting 4 project proposals were submitted, one of which was at award stage and the remaining 3 were at evaluation stage.





#### Call 4 - [UP3] Data Collection [Second Call]

- **Eligible Applicants:** Ministry for Sustainable Development, the Environment and Climate Change [MSDEC]
- Call Closing Date: 30<sup>th</sup> March 2017
- Amount Allocated for the Call: € 2,604,485.00 [Public Eligible]
- Awarded Public Eligible Amount: currently being evaluated
- **EMFF Co-Financing Rate:** 80%
- Call type: Restricted
- Project Duration: 31<sup>st</sup> December 2020





#### Call 5 - [UP1] Research

- **Eligible Applicants:** Ministry for Sustainable Development, the Environment and Climate Change [MSDEC]
- Call Closing Date: 5th May 2017
- Amount Allocated for the Call: € 200,000 [Public Eligible]
- Awarded Public Eligible Amount: currently being evaluated
- **EMFF Co-Financing Rate:** 75%
- **Call type:** Restricted
- **Project Duration:** 1st Quarter 2019





#### Call 5 - [UP1] Research [cont.]

- A restricted call was issued on the 3<sup>rd</sup> April 2017 on the basis of Article 39 of Regulation (EU) No. 508/2014, inviting the MSDEC to submit applications.
- Potential Operations: Innovation linked to the conservation of marine biological resources
- Another call may be issued in 2017 in case funds are still to be committed





#### Call 6 - [UP1] Training

- **Eligible Applicants:** Ministry for Sustainable Development, the Environment and Climate Change [MSDEC]
- Call Closing Date: 31st May 2017
- Amount Allocated for the Call: € 500,000 [Public Eligible]
- Awarded Public Eligible Amount: call currently open
- **EMFF Co-Financing Rate:** 75%
- **Call type:** Restricted
- **Project Duration:** 1st Quarter 2019





#### Call 6 - [UP1] Training

- A restricted call was issued on the 26<sup>th</sup> April 2017 on the basis of Article 29(1) and (2) and Article 44(1)(a) of Regulation (EU) No. 508/2014, inviting the MSDEC to submit applications.
- **Potential Operations**: Training course provided to eligible fishers
- Another call may be issued in 2017 in case funds are still to be committed





#### **Upcoming Calls**

- **[UP3] Article 76 Control and Enforcement** 
  - Minimum budget allocated: € 5,692,102
  - EMFF Co-financing rate: 90% (where applicable)
  - Tentative Launch Date: June 2017
- [UP5] Article 68 Marketing Measures
  - Minimum budget allocated : € 250,000
  - EMFF Co-financing rate: 75%
  - Tentative Launch Date: June 2017
- [UP1] Article 41.2 Modernisation or Replacement of Main or Ancillary Engines
  - Minimum budget allocated: € 40,000 [exact amount to be determined following EC approval for amendment to OP]
  - EMFF Co-financing rate: 50%
  - Tentative Launch Date: September 2017

#### **Update on OP/UP Commitments**

- With reference to remaining calls planned to be issued in 2017 together with the calls already issued in 2016, the MA foresees that about EUR 17,500,00 will be committed by Q1 2018 [following closure and evaluation of the respective calls].
- This will amount to about 60.5% of the allocated Total Public Eligible (EU + MT).
- The remaining funds [if any] are planned be committed in 2018.

#### **SPECIFIC Ex-Ante Conditionalities: Actions taken**

[1 - Report on fishing capacity has been submitted in accordance with Article 22(2) of Regulation (EU) No 1380/2013.]

- Following the submission of the Fleet Capacity Report for the year 2015, this specific ex-ante conditionality is now considered as fulfilled as per feedback given by EC (Ref ARES(2016)2585582) on 12<sup>th</sup> December 2016.
- The EC noted that "further to the receipt of the Report on 3 June 2016.. concluded that Malta is in line with the Commission's guidelines for the analysis of the balance between fishing capacity and fishing opportunities according to Art 22 of Regulation [EU] No.1380/2013 of the European Parliament and the Council on the CFP."
