



Modification of the NP (2)



In September 2019, the RA submitted an amendment to the NP to introduce ETIAS and SIS Recast both of which resulted from additional funding from the European Commission like EES. This was adopted by the Commission on 29/11/2019.

The latest NP amendment was requested in July 2020 and concerned the introduction of 2 Specific Action Projects. This was adopted by the Commission on 28/09/2020.






Proposed updates to the NP

- Training and Networking Seminar on Migration Annual Event 2019 –
 AMIF and ISF (organized by the RA).
- The COVID-19 pandemic has brought unprecedented challenges and to that effect, training courses which were to be carried out in 2020 had to be reworked and in some instances such courses did not materialize.

Programming Operation Maintenance SOE

- The Migration and Security Information System has been launched in June 2016.
- So far 136 active users.
- 1,200 claims for payment have been processed under ISF.
 These do not include payments processed through Technical Assistance.
- Further updates to the system are envisaged.

 Coordinating the drafting of all EU funded plans and programmes, including JHA, for next Multi-Annual Financial Framework 2021 – 2027, to ensure synergies, complementarity and demarcation.

Progress thus far:

- Between 2019 and 2020, SID carried out consultations across the main stakeholders identified for both Funds regarding the possible types of actions and policy developments related to the 2021-2027 period.
- A list of investment priorities for Malta were also identified by the European Commission in the BMVI and ISF programming fiches published in December 2019.

Programming Phase



Enabling conditions

- Enabling conditions are a pre-requisite for supporting projects through EU funding.
- 3 horizontal enabling conditions are applicable for these programmes.
- As present, Ministries are actively working on ensuring fulfilment of conditions.
- Another round of consultations with relevant entities is currently underway in particular to take stock of the fulfilment of the outstanding enabling conditions.
- All three enabling conditions are envisaged to be completed by end of 2020.

BMVI - <u>Policy Objective</u>: Ensuring strong and effective European integrated border management at the external borders, while safeguarding the free movement of persons within it, in full compliance with the Union's commitments on fundamental rights.

ISF: <u>Policy Objective</u>: To ensure a high level of security in the Union in particular by preventing and tackling terrorism and radicalization, serious and organized crime and cybercrime, by managing effectively security-related risks and crises and by assisting and protecting victims of crime.

^{*} In line with Article 7 of the proposed BMVI and ISF Regulations, additional funds shall be allocated for thematic facility.



Finalising the first consolidated BMVI and ISF Programmes for Government consideration;

- Engaging in informal dialogue with the European Commission on the drafted BMVI and ISF Programmes;
- Finalising the Strategic Environmental Assessment on the BMVI Programme;
- Updating the Monitoring Committee, carrying out wider consultations as necessary; and
- Officially submitting the programmes to the European Commission.


