Introduction

Designation

- The Funds and Programmes Division [FPD] was designated as the EMFF Managing Authority [MA] on the 18th October 2016.
- The Internal Audit and Investigations Department formally designated the FPD as the EMFF MA and EU Paying Authority as the Certifying Authority [CA] on the basis of the designation criteria set out in Annex XIII of Regulation [EU] No. 1303/2013.
- Documentation and tools necessary for the Designation of the EMFF MA: Description of Management and Controls System; EMFF MoP; CA Internal MoP; EMFF National Eligibility Rules, Project Selection Committee Manual; Fraud Risk Register; Risk Register; EMFF DB 2014-2020.

Call 1 - [UP3] Data Collection

- **Eligible Applicants:** Ministry for Sustainable Development, the Environment and Climate Change [MSDEC]
- Call Closing Date: Friday 29th April 2016
- Amount Allocated for the Call: € 2,500,000 [Public Eligible]
- Awarded Public Eligible Amount: € 1,822,425
- **EMFF Co-Financing Rate:** 80%
- **Call type:** Restricted
- Project Duration: 2nd Quarter 2017





Call 1 - [UP3] Data Collection [cont.]

- A restricted call was issued on the 11th March 2016 on the basis of Article 77 of Regulation [EU] No. 508/2014, inviting the MSDEC to submit an application.
- In line with the EMFF OP, for the period 2014-2016 Malta will implement the National Programme 2014 2016 as laid down in the Commission Decision C[2013] 5568 of 30th August 2013.
- Operation Summary: This operation includes the collection, use and management of fisheries data in line with Council Regulation EC No. 199/2008 and Commission Decision [2010/93/EU] and as outlined in the National Programme for the collection of primary biological, technical, environmental and socio-economic data in the fisheries sector of the Republic of Malta, 2011 2013 National Programme.





Call 2 - [UP6] Fostering the Implementation of the IMP

- **Eligible Applicants:** MSDEC
- **Application Closing Date:** Wednesday 10th August 2016
- Amount Allocated for the Call: € 1,600,000 [Public Eligible]
- Awarded Public Eligible Amount: € 1,600,000
- **EMFF Co-Financing Rate:** 75%
- **Call type:** Restricted
- **Project Duration:** 1st Quarter 2019





Call 2 - [UP6] Fostering the Implementation of the IMP [cont.]

- A restricted call was issued on the 9th June 2016 on the basis of Article 80.1[c] of Regulation [EU] No. 508/2014, inviting the MSDEC [as a co-ordinating body] to submit an application.
- The **Environment and Resources Authority** [ERA] in partnership with Malta Marittima Agency, Department of Fisheries and Aquaculture and Transport Malta applied for this call.
- Operation Summary: The project will initiate the implementation of sustained environmental monitoring in marine waters with the aim to assess the state of Malta's marine waters on a continuous basis and address current knowledge gaps. This monitoring would provide a sound knowledge base for effective management of anthropogenic activities and work towards achievement of Good Environmental Status [GES] in marine waters.





Call 3 - [UP1] Fishing Ports, Landing Sites, Auction Halls & Shelters

- Eligible Applicants: MSDEC; Ministry for Transport and Infrastructure (MTI)
- **Application Closing Date:** Friday 30th November 2016
- **Amount Allocated:** € 9,230,572 [Public Eligible]
- Eligible Amount: to be determined
- **EMFF Co-Financing Rate:** 75%
- Call type: Restricted
- Project Duration: to be determined





Call 3 - [UP1] Fishing Ports, Landing Sites, Auction Halls & Shelters [cont.]

- A **restricted call** was issued on the **20th October 2016** on the basis of **Article 43.1+3 + 44.1[f] of Regulation [EU] No. 508/2014**, inviting the MSDEC and MTI to submit applications.
- <u>Potential Operations</u>: Improving the infrastructure in fishing ports and existing landing sites.
- Another call may be issued in 2017 in case funds are still to be committed.





Upcoming Calls

- [UP1] Article 41.2 Replacement or Modernisation of Main and/or Ancillary Engines
 - Amount Allocated: € 200,000 [exact amount to be determined following EC approval for amendment to OP]
 - EMFF Co-financing rate: 50%
- [UP1] Article 29.1 + 29.2 Promoting Human Capital and Social Dialogue
 - Amount Allocated: € 500,000
 - EMFF Co-financing rate: 75%
- Calls will be issued within the coming months

Update on OP/UP Commitments

In light of the calls issued in 2016 under UP1, UP3 and UP6, the MA foresees that about EUR12.6M will be committed by Q2 2017 [following closure and evaluation of Call 3 under UP1]. This translates to circa 44% of allocated EMFF Funds.

With reference to calls planned to be issued in 2017, the MA foresees that about EUR13.5M will be committed by Q1 2018 [following closure and evaluation of the respective calls]. This will amount to about 47% of allocated EMFF Funds.

In this regard, by Q1 2018 a total of EUR 26.1M is foreseen to be committed amounting to about 91% of allocated EMFF Funds.

The EMFF Database



- Meetings held between the MA and the developer [MITA] in order to discuss various aspects allowing the development of the various modules.
- The operational and functional aspects of each developed module were subsequently **tested by the**Managing Authority and any identified issues were rectified accordingly.
- Data groups and functionality roles were developed and implemented.
- The database records and stores required data as per applicable rules, namely:
 - Commission Implementing Regulation [EU] No 1242/2014
 - Commission Implementing Regulation [EU] No 1243/2014
 - Commission Delegated Regulation [EU] No 480/2014





Online Application Form

- Development of the online application form:
 - **Testing Phase** [discussions held between the MA and MITA especially in light of different data to be captured by the system as per applicable rules]
- Following drafting of applications by the MA, applications and calls for applications are created through a specific menu on the EMFF DB. Subsequent to the publication of calls, applicants will be required to fill in and submit applications online. All applications received are recorded in the database.
- The online application form is developed and integrated within the system [EMFF Database 14-20], simplifying the process for the applicant.
