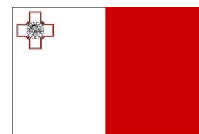
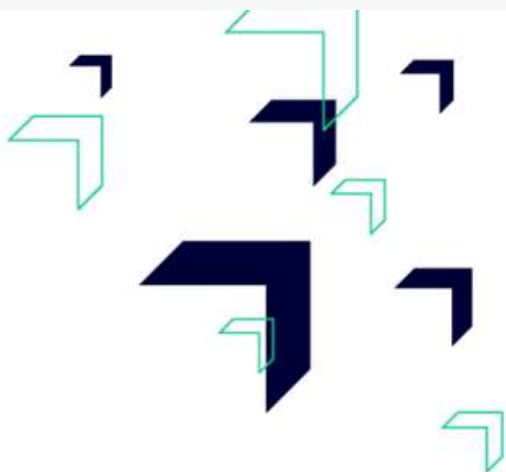

# Overview

- Thematic facility (TF) has been introduced as a separate financial envelope to the budget allocated for shared management under all three funds.
- It is meant to serve as a flexibility mechanism in the management of the Funds enabling the allocation of additional funds to various priorities through different components of the Facility.
- The priorities defined in the Work Programmes for TF are meant to complement funding under the AMIF/ISF/BMVI Programmes.
- Actions can be implemented through shared, direct or indirect management.
- Funding is defined in terms of multi-annual work programmes.
- TF aims to improve Member States' responsiveness to emerging needs with better planned and targeted activities.

## Multi-annual Work Programmes 2023 – 2025

- Financing decisions are adopted by the Commission by means of implementing acts, in line with the AMIF/BMVI/ISF Regulations, for the thematic facility, stipulating objectives and foreseen actions as well as specifying the amounts for each of the components.
- The following financing decisions were adopted contributing towards the 2023 – 2025 Work Programmes in order to ensure the implementation of the TF components:

## Implementation Arrangements

- The maximum union contribution for the implementation of the work programme for the years 2023, 2024, 2025 for the AMIF, BMVI, ISF TF are as follows:
  - AMIF: EUR 1 491 million
  - BMVI: EUR 1 035 million
  - ISF: EUR 222 million
  
- Work Programmes include actions to be financed for:
  - Grants
  - Procurement
  - Actions implemented under indirect/shared management
  - Other actions or expenditure

## Types of Actions – AMIF WP 2023 - 2025

- *Grants*
  - The protection of children in migration
  - Integration measures
  - Assistance, support and integration of TCN victims of human trafficking
  - Prevention of irregular migration
  
- *Indirect Management*
  - Direct Award (such as Emergency Assistance and Cooperation & Partnership with third countries)
  
- *Shared Management*
  - Specific Actions
  - Resettlement and humanitarian admission
  - Solidarity Package (Relocation)
  
- *Other actions*
  - European Migration Liaison Officers

## Types of Actions – BMVI WP 2023 - 2025

- *Grants*
  - Digitalisation of travel documents (direct award)
  - Development of national quality assurance mechanism
  - Projects on innovative solutions ensuring the well functioning of Schengen area
  - Emergency Assistance (direct award)
  
- *Indirect Management*
  - Migration Partnership Facility
  - Emergency Assistance
  
- *Shared Management*
  - Specific Actions
  
- *Other actions*
  - Development of a verification App

## Types of Actions – ISF WP 2023 - 2025

- *Grants*
  - Transnational actions on internal security
  - Direct Award in the fields of Counter Terrorism, Organised Crime
  - Law Enforcement Cooperation, Cybercrime, Emergency Assistance
  
- *Indirect Management*
  - Support to the UN Office on Drugs and Crime
  - Migration Partnership Facility
  - Emergency Assistance
  
- *Shared Management*
  - Specific Actions
  
- *Other actions*
  - Joint Research Centre support for counter terrorism policy

- Integration Measures (January 2023)

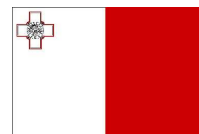
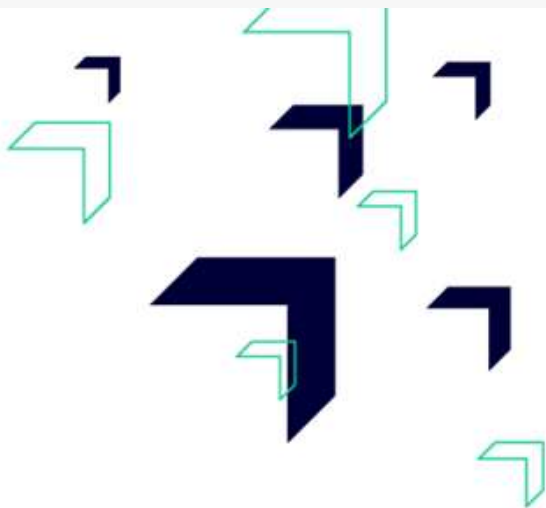
### **BMVI:**
