



Overview



- Thematic facility (TF) has been introduced as a separate financial envelope to the budget allocated for shared management under all three funds.
- It is meant to serve as a flexibility mechanism in the management of the Funds enabling the allocation of additional funds to various priorities through different components of the Facility.
- The priorities defined in the Work Programmes for TF are meant to complement funding under the AMIF/ISF/BMVI Programmes.
- Actions can be implemented through shared, direct or indirect management.
- Funding is defined in terms of multi-annual work programmes.
- TF aims to improve Member States' responsiveness to emerging needs with better planned and targeted activities.

Multi-annual Work Programmes 2023 – 2025



- Financing decisions are adopted by the Commission by means of implementing acts, in line with the AMIF/BMVI/ISF Regulations, for the thematic facility, stipulating objectives and foreseen actions as well as specifying the amounts for each of the components.
- The following financing decisions were adopted contributing towards the 2023 2025 Work Programmes in order to ensure the implementation of the TF components:

■ The maximum union contribution for the implementation of the work programme for the years 2023, 2024, 2025 for the AMIF, BMVI, ISF TF are as follows:

AMIF: EUR 1 491 million

BMVI: EUR 1 035 million

ISF: EUR 222 million
