Erasmus+ 2021-27 interim evaluation & Erasmus+ 2014-20 final evaluation

Erasmus+ is the EU's programme to support education, training, youth and sport in Europe.

In accordance with the legal base¹, the Commission is to perform, by 31 December 2024, an interim evaluation of the 2021- 2027 programme and a final evaluation of the 2014-2020 programme.

As required by the Erasmus+ Regulation, the evaluation will assess the overall effectiveness and performance of the programme, including as regards new initiatives and the delivery of inclusion and simplification measures. The new interim evaluation will make it possible to take account of the impact of improvements introduced and to provide coordinated recommendations for continuing the programme.

A call for evidence was launched on the 28th of July to obtain feedback on the programme. The aim of the consultation is to collect information, expertise and views from all interested parties in order to reach an evidence-based and measured judgement on how well the programme has performed.
