EU Youth Strategy 2019-2027 – interim evaluation

The EU Youth Strategy is the framework for EU youth policy cooperation for 2019-2027, based on the Council Resolution of 26 November 2018. In line with the Resolution, the European Commission will carry out an evaluation to support a mid-term review of the Strategy by the Council.

The Strategy focuses on three core areas of action: **Engage, Connect, Empower**, while working on joined-up implementation across sectors. It should help realise the vision of young people as expressed in the 11 European Youth Goals.

A call for evidence was launched on the 23rd of September. The public consultation will be based on a questionnaire aiming to gather assessments, data and evidence and to ensure that views from a wide spectrum of young people, stakeholders of the EU Youth Strategy and the general public are reflected in the evaluation.
