



Programme specificities

- The INTERREG V-A Italy-Malta 2014-2020 Programme, approved by the European Commission Implementing Decision C (2015) 7046 final of <u>12 October 2015</u>, is part of the "European Territorial Cooperation" objective of the European Union's Cohesion Policy.
- The Programme has a total budget of <u>51,708,438 euros</u> and covers the entire Sicilian territory (NUTS 3 areas: Palermo, Trapani, Caltanissetta, Agrigento, Ragusa, Siracusa, Enna, Catania and Messina) and the entire Maltese territory, involving a total population of about 5.4 million inhabitants.
- The main objective of the PC is to promote the integrated development of Sicily and Malta, acting on three main areas of intervention:
 - sustainable and intelligent growth through research and innovation;
 - the competitiveness of the cross-border area,
 - the protection of the environment and the efficient use of resources.


