

AMIF – Programme Modification




- Following the 2023 pledging exercise for resettlement and humanitarian admission under AMIF,
 Malta submitted a request to resettle 20 persons in 2023.
- The Commission allocated half of the envisaged budget foreseen for the year 2023 which was added to the existing total Programme allocation, as per Commission Communication of 25th April 2023.
- Funds allocated for resettlement are allocated through the thematic facility mechanism.
- A programme modification was required following the approval of the proposed thematic facility, carried out in June 2023.
- The relevant sections of the AMIF Programme were updated accordingly to reflect the additional allocation of € 106,000 (including technical assistance).
- Programme was officially resubmitted on 21st July 2023 and approved by EC on 20th September 2023.



BMVI – Programme Modification



- The Malta Police Force prepared a proposal for submission under the Specific Action call for expression of interest – Reference BMVI/2021/SA/1.5.4 for the support to comply with the implementation of the relevant interoperability legal framework.
- The Managing Authority submitted the application form in November 2022.
- A positive assessment was received by the European Commission in February 2023, through Commission notification ARES(2023)1066851 for support through thematic facility.
- Support will contribute towards extending the capacity of the SIRENE offices to resolve yellow links during the period that makes the Multiple Identity Detector (MID) operational. Reference to this action was introduced under Specific Objective 1 of the BMVI Programme.
- Total financial allocation is EUR 595,528 at a co-financing rate of 90%, which was added under SO1.
- Programme modification was sent in July 2023 and approved by Commission in September 2023.


