#ERASMUSDAYS 2023

The 2023 edition of #ErasmusDays, which took place from October 9th to 14th, 2023, under the patronage of the European Commission and the European Parliament, provided a unique opportunity for participants in the Erasmus+ programme to showcase their projects and share experiences. The theme for this year's edition was "6 days to make Europe shine" and "6 days to promote skills throughout Europe."



Over 50 countries participated, with coordination from all Erasmus+ National Agencies across Europe and events held globally with the help of European embassies networks and local Erasmus+ project partners. Malta took part in such an event and organised 12 activities.

The Europass Annual Conference, titled "Shaping Your Future." featured various activities and discussions to empower attendees for success. Mr. Ayrton Zarb addressed education and career readiness, emphasising the need for adaptability and diverse competencies. A workshop inspired by Dr. Edward De Bono's six thinking hats' facilitated decision-making and problem-solving, equipping attendees with versatile thinking tools. The conference provided a platform for thoughtprovoking discussions and practical tools to shape the educational and career landscape for students and professionals.

KEY ACTION 1 PROJECT LABS

The latest Erasmus+ funding applications for 2024 have led to innovative project labs designed to help individuals and organisations navigate the application process. The Youth Information Session held on November 30th provided comprehensive information on KA1 Erasmus+ opportunities in the youth sector and solidarity projects under the European Solidarity Corps. These labs also provided practical guides on creating innovative and effective project proposals, aligning with Erasmus+ objectives and criteria. Through interactive sessions and expert guidance, attendees gained a deep understanding of the application process, project management, and the importance of promoting inclusivity and diversity in their initiatives. As a result, they are now well-prepared with the necessary skills and knowledge to achieve their goals successfully, contribute to the growth and development of the Erasmus+ funds, and make a positive impact in their communities. These applications must be submitted by February 20, 2024, at noon.
