# Check out the courtesy AF !

Purpose and logic:

- The main purpose of this section is to have the project overview presented on one page (project identity, content summary, list of partners, total budget).
- This is the first part of the AF that the project partner sees when they enter the online system.
- All entries and options chosen in A.1 are connected to other parts of AF and reporting.
- Names of project partners can be either in the original language or English or in both languages.
- A.2 Project summary is needed for many different reasons, for example: to be published on the Programme's website, for evaluators, for Monitoring Committee, for keep.eu and for any other database collecting such information.
- A.3 Project budget overview is created automatically from Part D.
- A.4 Project outputs and results overview is created automatically from Part C4 and C5.





Thematic developments and policy uptakes

- **Database**: provide relevant information to feed the databases developped
- Working groups: participate in clustering process, development of synergies, collective thematic work (surveys, review of documents, provision of examples, etc.)
- **Networking activities (**in addition to mandatory joint event): participate in events for collective dissemination, transferring and integration processes
- Joint capacity building activities: participate in content development and or participate in training/mentoring/support processes offered by TCP
- **Transferring potential**: provide information to enable proper analysis of replicability, transferability and integration potential of project results
- Mainstream support: share previous experiences and mainstream methodologies



### **Convince your reader**



- Be Consistent with the call objectives, the actions, the budget, the partnership...
  Do's : read the intervention logic
- Be Concrete. Answer the question « How could my project lead to a concrete change » ?
   Do's : « By increasing the fraction of recycled plastic waste, the project will substancially reduce plastic waste generation from X tons of plastic used per year to X tons ».

#### Be precise and straightforward

**Do's** : « By promoting the restoration of water polluted environments, the project will contribute to goal 6 of the UN sustainable development »




### **TIPS per section**

- 1. Project relevance : show clearly the need tackled
- 2. Cooperation character : transnationality must be essential to reach results
- 3. Intervention logic : must be concrete/direct/coherent
- 4. Partnership relevance : careful to geographical balance, skills, roles dispatch
- 5. Horizontal principles : show contribution with concrete examples
- 6. Work plan : objectives (=WP) must be operational and well sequenced
- 7. Budget : well shared and reflecting the activities

- Read carefully the Programme Manual and the specific ToR
- Use the « list of administrative and eligibility criteria » and the specificities of the call to check your proposal
  - Double check all documents uploaded and their content
  - Follow our thematic and technical seminars

#### <u>Quality Assessment in 1 phase on :</u>

- project relevance,
- cooperation character,
- intervention logic,
- partnership relevance
- horizontal principles,
- work plan,
- budget



Rating based on 50 points (**35** out of 50 <u>at least</u> to be requested for <u>being eligible to approval</u>, <u>depending</u> <u>on available budget</u>)
