
The EERE FI being implemented partially under PA 4 and partially under PA 7 provides guarantees and an interest rate subsidy giving the opportunity to both private individuals and companies to avail themselves of loans to carry out RES and EE measures in buildings, as well as for the purchase of Electric Vehicles.

- > This FI was implemented through two local banks acting as Financial Intermediaries.
- As at end of December 2023, under the PA 4 portion, a total of 723 loans were concluded with a committed amount of €24.9M as per the following categories:


Under this PA, the EERE Financial Instrument is contributing towards the decarbonisation of Maltese roads primarily by incentivising private individuals to purchase green forms of transport.

It provides guarantees and interest rate subsidies to beneficiaries seeking out loans for this purpose.

As at end of December 2023, a total of 1,246 loans were approved to private individuals for green forms of transport with a total commitment of €40.6 M.

## Pinto 4/5 Quay and Lascaris Wharf



This project extends and aligns 2 existing quays to form a continuous new berth forming part of the Grand Harbour.

- Works at Pinto 4/5 will result in an extension of c. 236m of quay length.
- Works at Lascaris Quay will result in an extension of c. 100m of quay length.
- The project will increase port capacity within the Grand Harbour in a more sustainable manner to meet future expected demand.

## **A2E Scheme**


- > A portfolio volume of €117.2M of portfolio was reached, representing 99.5% of the budget.



## Loans committed and disbursed (millions)







- For ERDF/CF operations, 100% indicator checks are carried out bi-annually by the Evaluation Unit, confirming the methodology used and validating the supporting documentation substantiating the indicator values reported by beneficiaries.
- > For **ESF operations**, indicator checks by the Evaluation Unit are carried out on a sample basis.
- > This process promotes the four-eyed principle which ensures more accurate and reliable indicator reporting.

















## **DISABLED PARTICIPANTS: SUITABILITY OF**



- Wave 5 is expected to start in the coming months, covering participants completing/exiting from an ESF intervention between 1st January 2023 31st December 2023.
- Like previous waves, the study will be carried out via telephone surveys, through a stratified random sampling process. The National Statistics Office is the contractor carrying out this study and data collection exercise.

#### ➢ Wave 5 report expected in Q1 2025.

A final amalgamated report will cover all 5 waves, a summary of which will be reported in the Final Implementation Report.



## **REACT-EU Evaluations - Status**

- Two evaluations aimed to assess the effectiveness, efficiency, impact, and inclusiveness of the REACT-EU resources in Malta, under the respective Operational Programmes, and the extent to which the goals identified under the Thematic Objective have been achieved.
- Preliminary work tied to data availability was carried out with key stakeholders by the Evaluation Unit.
- Status: Contract signing stage/ Kick-off meeting.
- Final reports are planned to be concluded by November 2024, ahead of the 31 December 2024 deadline in line with the respective regulation.

## **Concluding Remarks (Step Regulation – Closure)**

- Regulation (EU) 2024/79 of the European Parliament and of the Council, establishing Strategic Technologies for Europe Platform (STEP) and amending, amongst others, EU Regulation 1303/2013 in February 2024 provided flexibility to Member States to ensure earlier full absorption of funds.
- The MA launched a written procedure for approval by the MC to amend Table 18A of the Operational Programme to apply a co-financing rate of 100% to expenditure declared in the final payment claim for all the Priority Axes funded under OPI and OPII.
- Approval has now been given by the members of this Committee for the proposed change to the 2 Operational Programmes.
- > This change will be communicated to the Commission via the SFC portal.

## **Concluding Remarks**



- The MA is closely monitoring the projects whose implementation is still ongoing to ensure timely conclusion thereof.
- Closure reports for all the projects which have been concluded are currently being drafted, contributing to reporting obligations of the Final Implementation Report.
- The MA will continue monitoring any non-functioning projects, in line with Article 7 of Commission Notice (2022/C 474/01), if applicable.
- Verification and subsequent certification of expenditure is expected to be concluded by not later than December 2024. Use of the flexibility offered by the STEP Regulation will facilitate reaching this target, now that the MC has approved the use of the 100% co-financing for all Priority Axis.
- In preparation for the submission of the Closure documentation, the MA will now be focusing on verification of indicators, with a special focus on the Performance Framework Indicators; evaluations and work related to audits. Cooperation from all stakeholders is critical to ensure the timely and successful conclusion of the 2014-2020 Programmes.
