Several EU countries report poor water quality in their territory and a systemic problem in managing nutrient pollution from agriculture and others have critical points where pollution is not adequately addressed. As a result, there is an urgent need to adopt additional measures to achieve the Nitrate Directive objectives and to improve public policies to support these efforts.
