

EMFAF Programme

- > Policy Objective 2 of the CPR is targeted by the Programme.
- ➤ Total Budget: 31.2mn (EU+MT)
- > 3 Priorities
- ➤ Adopted by the European Commission on 28th November 2022

Objective: Strengthen the resilience, sustainable development and management of the Maltese fisheries and aquaculture sectors within the scope of the EMFAF Regulation and with the objective of adapting to new and emerging needs, including climate change adaptation and the protection and restoration of the marine environment

Fostering sustainable blue investment in Maltese Fisheries and Aquaculture



Fostering sustainable fisheries and the restoration and conservation of aquatic biological resources

SO 1.1 Strengthening economically, social and environmentally sustainable fishing activities

Types of potential actions:

- Investments directly targeting fishers:
 - Investments on board fishing vessels
 - Advisory/ consultancy services
 - Diversification of fishing activities
 - Promotion of skills & knowledge: training and/or collective interest/ pilot projects
- > Improvement of key fishing port/landing infrastructure
- > Research studies aimed at improving the research base of the local fisheries sector with the aim of increasing sustainability and resilience

Funding for SO1.1 amounts to € 7.4Mn



Fostering sustainable fisheries and the restoration and conservation of aquatic biological resources

SO 1.2 Increasing energy efficiency and reducing CO2 emissions through the replacement or modernisation of engines of fishing vessels

Types of potential actions:

> Support for engine replacement and/or modernisation

Funding for SO1.2 amounts to € 200,000



Fostering sustainable fisheries and the restoration and conservation of aquatic biological resources

SO 1.3 Promoting the adjustment of fishing capacity to fishing opportunities in cases of permanent cessation of fishing activities and contributing to a fair standard of living in cases of temporary cessation of fishing activities

Types of potential actions:

Compensation for temporary cessation of fishing activities

Funding for SO1.3 amounts to € 400,000



Fostering sustainable fisheries and the restoration and conservation of aquatic biological resources

SO 1.4 Fostering efficient fisheries control and enforcement, including fighting against IUU fishing, as well as reliable data for knowledge-based decision-making

Types of potential actions:

- Data Collection
- > Control and enforcement activities

Funding for SO1.4 amounts to € 9Mn



Fostering sustainable fisheries and the restoration and conservation of aquatic biological resources

SO 1.6 Contributing to the protection and restoration of aquatic biodiversity and ecosystems

Types of potential actions:

- > Passive collection of marine litter
- Implementation of management measures linked with MPAs (Project of strategic importance)
- > Engaging fishers in MPA management processes
- Restoration and Management of Seagrass Meadows

Funding for SO1.6 amounts to € 7.8Mn



Fostering sustainable aquaculture activities, and processing and marketing of fisheries and aquaculture products, thus contributing to food security in the Union

SO2.1 Promoting sustainable aquaculture activities, especially strengthening the competitiveness of aquaculture production, while ensuring that the activities are environmentally sustainable in the long term

Types of potential actions:

- > Research &Innovation Actions through:
 - Research and development on domestication of aquaculture species to promote species diversification (Project of Strategic Importance)
 - Identification of alternative feeds including algae species
 - Actions aimed at valorising aquaculture by supporting decarbonisation of the sector, further minimising
 its carbon footprint and/or improving its environmental performance
 - Actions related to climate change impacts, adaptation, risk prevention and resilience of the sector
 - Transfer of knowledge, exchange and training actions





Fostering sustainable aquaculture activities, and processing and marketing of fisheries and aquaculture products, thus contributing to food security in the Union

SO2.2 Promoting marketing, quality and added value of fisheries and aquaculture products, as well as processing of those products

Types of potential actions:

➤ Marketing Measures & Awareness-Raising Campaign

Funding for SO2.2 amounts to € 1.5Mn

Priority 2: Technical Assistance



Types of potential actions:

- > Actions pertaining to preparation, management, monitoring, evaluation, information and communication, networking, complaint resolution, as well as control and audit
- Actions for the reduction of the administrative burden on beneficiaries, including electronic data exchange systems
- > Actions to reinforce the capacity of MS Authorities and beneficiaries to administer and use the fund
- > Actions to support the strengthening of the institutional capacity of partners
- > Reports and studies related to the sectors supported through this Programme
- Actions to support in the preparation of the Programme post-2027




