

Social Media Statistics


Number of Posts – January to September 2024

Annual Event 2024








The **annual event** took place during the Public Service Expo which welcomed 33,000 visitors, from the 15th to the 19th of May 2024 at the Malta Fairs & Conventions Centre (MFCC) in Ta' Qali. The major attraction was an **immersive room** with six distinct productions about some of the most successful projects and how European Funds transformed Malta throughout the past twenty years.

EU Fair & Europe Day

An EU Fair was organised on the 1st of May in Ta' Qali.

On the 9th and 10th of May, the Europe Day celebrations organised by SEM and Europe Direct took place in Valletta, with various organisations providing European Union related information to visitors, guidance and support on the rights and opportunities available to EU citizens.



Beach Cleanup Event

On 20th September, the FONDI.eu team and representatives from the Managing Authorities, SEM and the European Commission Representation in Malta took part in a beach cleanup event at White Tower Bay in Armier.





The event was part of the #WorldCleanupDay efforts and a staggering amount of **1,050kg** of waste was collected.

This cleanup also supported the Marine Environmental Monitoring project, partially funded under the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund. The project improves marine knowledge and manages better Malta's marine environment as part of the EU Integrated Maritime Policy.

On 30th October, representatives from the Managing Authority and the FONDI.eu team accompanied a CION representative on a visit to AquaBioTech Group.


AquaBioTech Group representatives explained two EMFF projects in detail:

- Development of new, innovative aquaculture technologies and facilitate knowledge transfer in AquaBioTech Group; and
- Productive investment in non-food aquaculture using Recirculation Aquaculture Systems (RAS) in AquaBioTech Group to improve resource efficiency, reducing usage of water and chemicals as well as to ensure the safe operation of existing and new RAS units.

TV & Radio Slots
