New College of Commissioners 2024-2029

- European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen presented to the European Parliament her Political Guidelines for the next European Commission 2024-2029
- Mission Letters to all Commissioners-designate
- Commissioner-designate for Fisheries and Oceans: Mr. Costas Kadis
- Hearing of Commissioner-designate Mr. Costas Kadis on 6 November 2024



Evaluation of the Common Fisheries Policy (CFP) Regulation

- Evaluation objective: to provide an evidence-based assessment of whether the CFP Regulation is still fit for purpose or where lessons can be learned for improving
- In line with Commission's Better Regulation Standards; assessment five key evaluation criteria: efficiency, effectiveness, relevance, coherence, EU added value
- Public feedback was collected till 6 September on the "Have your say" portal, 87 responses
- 12 weeks public consultation will be launched by end of 2024 via e-survey questionnaire
- Study supporting the evaluation will be conducted by an external Contractor
- Final product is the evaluation report a staff working document drafted by the Commission

EMFF and **EMFAF** evaluations

- EMFF ex-post evaluation and EMFAF mid-term evaluation in parallel
- Supported by external studies conducted over the past year
- Application of various methodological tools and approaches
- Reach-out to the wider public (call for evidence, public consultation, surveys, targeted interviews and consultations, validation workshops etc.)
- Evaluation studies expected to be finalised by end 2024
- Results of the studies and staff working documents to be published in spring 2025



Other studies and consultations

- Foresight study "Fishers of the future": launched in November 2023, expected delivery by November-December 2024
- Training and Certification of Fishers across EU coastal Member States: launched in 2024, expected delivery by December 2024
- Management of EU fishing capacity: initiated in 2024, expected delivery by June 2025
- Common Market Organisation (CMO) provisions labelling and producer organisations: launched in October 2024, duration of 10 months (until July 2025)
- Consultations on social indicators and quota allocation closed: ongoing assessment of responses related to Fishing Opportunities and upcoming engagement with Member States and stakeholders

Multiannual Financial Framework (MFF)

Commission to present a proposal on the next MFF Regulation by 1st
July 2025

MFF proposal determines the overall EU budget allocation

 DG MARE's evaluation work specific to the funding and CFP helps define the best use of the budget available to the specific policy area of DG MARE in the next funding period

- Other documents in progress: Access to space and water for freshwater and pond aquaculture; Climate change adaptation; Environmental performance; Energy transition; Code of good practices on fish welfare and fish welfare indicators.

- Launch of EU-wide campaign on aquaculture:
 - ✓ Aim: to raise awareness, understanding and acceptance of aquaculture among citizens and those who have a say at local level on the development of the sector
 - ✓ Commission will prepare tools that can be used by Member States
 - ✓ Planned kick-off March 2025



Nature Restoration Law (NRL)

- NRL adopted by European Parliament in February 2024; respective Regulation published in the EU Official Journal during summer 2024
- NRL directly applicable in the Member States
- Each Member State to develop and submit to the Commission a National Restoration Plan within two years from the entry into force of the Regulation (August 2026)
- Interplay with the CFP: where the protection of coastal and marine habitats requires that fishing or aquaculture activities are regulated
- Financial support: current EMFAF programming period remains unaffected
- Close collaboration within the national administration is required
