

#### Introduction



**Asylum Migration and Integration Fund (AMIF)** 

Adopted on the 19.09.2022 Total Budget - €43.8m Internal Security Fund (ISF)

Adopted on the 27.10.2022

Total Budget - €22.7m

Border Management and Visa Instrument (BMVI)

Adopted on the 19.09.2022 Total Budget – €38.4m



#### **Calls for Project Proposals**

- A total of 15 Calls for Applications were launched under all AMIF/BMVI/ISF Programmes since October 2023; 6 calls under AMIF Programme (under SO1, SO2 and SO4), 5 calls under BMVI (all under SO2) and 4 calls under ISF Programme (under SO1 and SO3).
- The majority of the launched calls for applications were restricted in view of the nature of the activities foreseen, in line with the respective Programmes.
- Urgency to launch applications prompted by regulatory commitments Article 17 (AMIF), Article 14 (BMVI & ISF) stipulating that where at least 10% of the initial allocation to a programme is covered by payment applications, the Member State will be eligible for an additional allocation for its programme as part of the Mid-Term review.

Call No. 9	Provision of pre-integration services for TCNs (Open)	Closed on 15 <sup>th</sup> February 2024. PSC evaluation conclusion. 7 applications received and three approved projects for a total cost of EUR 6,331,915.54.
Call No. 10	Promoting diversity, embracing ethnicity and providing support services to TCNs in the educational sector (Open)	Closed on 26 <sup>th</sup> June 2024. No applications received.
Call No. 11	Support victims of human trafficking (Open)	Closed on 15 <sup>th</sup> July 2024. Evaluation of the projects has been concluded and a project has been awarded on 13 <sup>th</sup> September 2024 for a total project cost of EUR 1,097,850.04

Call Reference	Type of Action	Status
Call No. 5	Enhancing protection of public spaces (Restricted)	Closed on 5 <sup>th</sup> April 2024. The evaluation has been concluded and the project was approved on 6 <sup>th</sup> May 2024 with a total project cost of EUR 680,000.
Call No. 8	Maximizing the abilities of financial investigative networks against financial crime (Restricted)	Closed on 18 <sup>th</sup> October 2024. Application is currently being evaluated by the PSC.
Call No. 9	Enhancing information sharing solutions to tackle encrypted devices, malware analysis and big data (Restricted)	Closed on 27th June 2024. One application has been received however this was deemed ineligible by the PSC.
Call No. 11	Enhancing protection of public spaces (Restricted)	This call will close on 20 <sup>th</sup> December 2024.

Call Reference	Type of Action	Status
Call No. 5	Supporting a common visa policy – Upgrade NVIS and operating support (Restricted)	Closed on 22 <sup>nd</sup> April 2024. The application was received and awarded-on 4 <sup>th</sup> September for a total project cost of EUR 963,000.
Call No. 6	Strengthening consular coverage (Restricted)	Closed on 22 <sup>nd</sup> April 2024. An application has been received however it was deemed ineligible by the PSC.
Call No. 8	Capacity building on visa related matters (Restricted)	Closed on 30 <sup>th</sup> September 2024. Call currently being evaluated.
Call No. 9	Operating support for visa policy – strengthening capacity in consular posts (Restricted)	Closed on 6 <sup>th</sup> September 2024. Call currently being evaluated.
Call No. 10	Strengthening consular coverage (Restricted)	Call closed on 1 <sup>st</sup> November 2024. Evaluation of the application to commence shortly.







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#### **NP Allocation vs. Disbursements**





## National Programme – ISF Borders and ISF Police









#### **Disbursements Made vs NP Allocation**








