




ISF and BMVI Programme Modifications



18th November 2024



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Amendment of Programmes

- In line with Article 24 of the Common Provisions Regulation (CPR), Member States may submit a reasoned request for an amendment of a programme, together with the amended programme, setting out the expected impact of that amendment on the achievement of the objectives.
- The Commission shall assess the amendment and its compliance with the Common Provisions Regulation and with the Fund specific Regulation, including requirements at national level.
- The Commission shall adopt a decision approving the amendment of a programme no later than 4 months after its submission by the Member State.
- For programmes supported by the AMIF, the ISF and the BMVI, the Member State may transfer during the programming period allocations between types of actions within the same priority and, in addition, an amount of up to 15 % of the initial allocation of a priority to another priority of the same Fund.

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ISF – Programme Modification

- Operating support was required under SO 1 for the maintenance of ICT systems and technical equipment that contribute to the achievement of the objectives set out in the Regulation.
- As a result of this, operating support was included under Specific Objective 1 'Exchange of information' in line with Article 16 Operating Support and point 1 (a) of Annex VII Expenditure Eligible For Operating Support of the ISF Regulation (EU) 2021/1149.
- A financial shift of EUR 3,735,000.00 from Type of action: 'Annex IV actions' to 'Operating support' under SO 1.
- The co-financing rate contribution from the Union budget will be 100% of the total eligible expenditure.
- In parallel, amendment not related to operating support was carried out to the ISF Performance Framework
 Methodology.
- The ISF Programme modification request was sent for review by the EC on 4 October 2024.

Border Management and Visa Instrument (BMVI) – Programme Modification

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BMVI – Programme Modification

- The Malta Police Force prepared a proposal for submission under the Specific Action call for expression of interest Reference BMVI/2021/SA/1.5.1 for the Support to Member States for Smart Borders.
- The Managing Authority submitted the application form in May 2024.
- A positive assessment was received by the European Commission in July 2024, through Commission notification ARES(2024)5488311 for support through thematic facility.
- The specific action aims to support readiness for the implementation of the EES and the ETIAS, the timeline for its implementation should in general be in line with the date of the start of operations of these systems as determined by the Commission.
- Total financial allocation is EUR 2,133,333 at a co-financing rate of 90%, which was added under SO1.
- Programme modification was sent in October 2024 and is still pending approval by Commission.

Brief Narrative of the Specific Action



Support to Member States for Smart Borders (Specific Action – BMVI/2024/SA/1.5.1)

In addition to the actions identified above, assistance is required to support Malta's preparations at the national level for the entry into operation of EES and ETIAS (Lot 1) and for the necessary changes to the SIRENE Bureaux Case management systems related to implementation and operation of ETIAS (Lot 2). The European Commission approved the requested funding under this Specific Action in August 2024.

This Specific Action implemented with the support of the Fund will contribute towards implementation measure (1e) through the actions outlined in Annex III (3a and d).

As regards the contribution of this specific action to the output/result indicators, the large IT systems linked to this specific action were already listed under Output Indicator 1.11 and sub-indicator 1.11.1, thus already foreseen in the programme. The main difference brought by this specific action is that the Member State now has more funding to cover the costs, which were not financed under the 2014-2020 Programme. This means that the additional resources have an impact only on the financial envelope and not on the indicators, as the financed IT systems remain three (3).
