




Update on Programming and the Enabling Conditions for the AMIF, BMVI and ISF Programmes

Enabling Conditions

- As stipulated in Article 40(1) of the Common Provisions Regulation, the Monitoring Committee shall examine the fulfilment of Enabling Conditions and their application throughout the programming period.
- The Member State shall ensure that Enabling Conditions remain fulfilled and respected throughout the programming period.
- The Strategy & Programming Unit, within the SID, takes on the role of monitoring the fulfilment of the Enabling Conditions.



Enabling Conditions

• 3 Horizontal Enabling Conditions are applicable to the AMIF, BMVI and ISF Programmes:

Horizontal Enabling Condition	Status of Fulfilment
G.1 – Effective monitoring mechanisms of the public procurement market	Fulfilled
G.3 – Effective application and implementation of the Charter of Fundamental Rights	Fulfilled
G.4 – Implementation and application of the United Nations Convention on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (UNCRPD) in accordance with Council Decision 2010/48/EC	Fulfilled

• These Enabling Conditions were deemed fulfilled at programming stage, and remain fulfilled to date.



Enabling Conditions – Monitoring

- SID will continue to monitor the fulfilment of all Enabling Conditions through engagement and follow up actions, as necessary.
- SID has recently introduced a new online monitoring tool system that will ease communication and facilitate the monitoring of Enabling Conditions.
- The system forms part of the SFD structure that most MC members are familiar with, and aims to improve transparency and record-keeping of communication related to all Enabling Conditions.
- Training and guidelines on the use of the tool will be held in the next months.

Asylum and Migration Pact

- The Asylum and Migration Pact has been recently adopted by the Council at EU level, and consists of a set of new rules managing migration and establishing a common asylum system at EU level.
- The thematic areas addressed include: Secure external borders; Fast and efficient procedures;
 Effective system of solidarity and responsibility; and Embedding migration in international partnerships.
- Member States are required to put in place the legal and operational capabilities required to successfully start applying the new legislation by 2026.
- Discussions are currently ongoing with the relevant Ministry on the drafting of the National Implementation Plan and the respective priorities which may be considered for funding under the HOME Fund Programmes.
