




Update on the status of Implementation of the AMIF, ISF and BMVI Programmes 2021-2027

Adopted on the 27.10.2022

Total Budget - €22.7m

Border Management and Visa Instrument (BMVI)

Adopted on the 19.09.2022 Total Budget – €38.4m





- A total of 12 Calls for Applications were launched under all AMIF/BMVI/ISF Programmes since November 2024; 3 calls under AMIF Programme (under SO1, SO2), 5 calls under BMVI (all under SO1) and 4 calls under ISF Programme (under SO1 and SO3).
- The majority of the launched calls for applications were restricted in view of the nature of the activities foreseen, in line with the respective Programmes.







NP Allocation, Disbursements, Certified







Disbursements Made, NP Allocation, Certification Amounts






