





Training Sessions on Communications and Publicity

Sessions equip participants with practical skills to utilise tools such as the Visual Identity Guidelines and the FONDI.eu publicity online generator.

Target Groups: Managing Authorities, Paying Agency, Beneficiaries, Line Ministries, Local Action Groups, Intermediate Bodies.

Sessions were held between June and November for various stakeholders.



Visit by Commissioner Roxana Minzatu

Commissioner Roxana Minzatu – Executive Vice-President for Social Rights and Skills, Quality Jobs and Preparedness, visited Malta in October 2025.

Discussions with Maltese Authorities were focused on investment in jobs and skills and how Europe's Multiannual Financial Framework proposals and upcoming initiatives - like the Quality Jobs Roadmap and Fair Labour Mobility package - can support quality jobs, fair transitions, social inclusion, education and skilling.


Operations of Strategic Importance

Second Interconnector between Malta and Italy – Ragusa Terminal Station


